
MEDICAL GUIDANCE FLOWCHART Class: C

⁽¹⁾ No significant symptoms and adequate rate control if paroxysmal persistent or permanent.

^(1A)Acceptable treatment for rhythm control includes Sotalol, Bisoprolol, Digitalis, Diltiazem and Verapamil. Exceptionally. Following initiation or change in medication to achieve compliance with criteria (Note 1), flying may resume **after 3 months** if there is no further recurrence or if clinical criteria (Note 1) are satisfied during recurrences.

⁽²⁾ Attending cardiologist to decide of nessesity. If indicated minimum 9 minutes duration of test with no significant abnormality of rhythm or conduction, nor evidence of ischemia.

- ⁽³⁾ Assessment of Stroke and or Cardiac event Risk (in %)
- ⁽⁴⁾ SSL Copy of all medical records to AME

⁽⁵⁾ Following cessation of anticoagulant therapy, for any indication, cabin crew members should undergo a re-assessment.
